



The Broads are made up of over 125 miles of navigable waterways, or roughly the same as the straight-line distance between Norwich and Oxford!




The Broads are sometimes wrongly referred to as 'The Norfolk Broads'. The reason this is wrong is because part of it (River Waveney) extends into Suffolk.

The Broads contains the highest concentration of medieval churches in the world!
